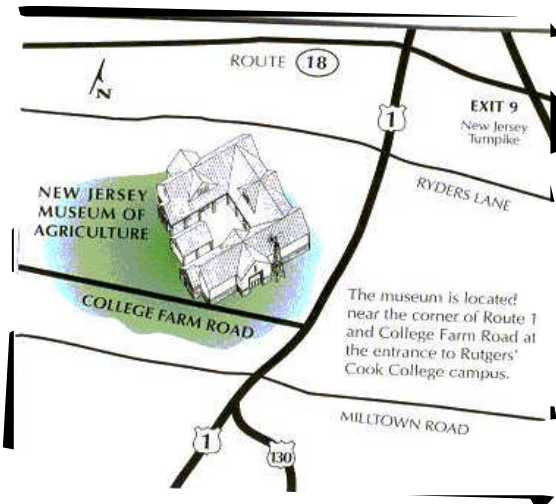

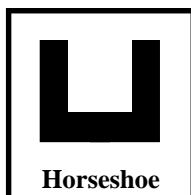
Hall of Machines

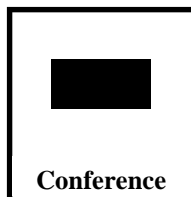

Room Set-up



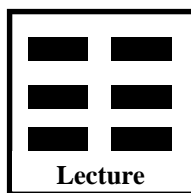
Horseshoe

Horseshoe style is optimum for presenters and speakers who are looking for feedback from the group, yet also allows the front of the room to be the center of focus.



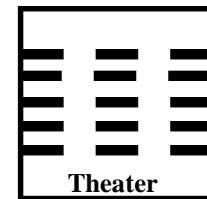
Conference

Conference style allows for maximum communication between all group members, allowing everyone to sit and see each other.



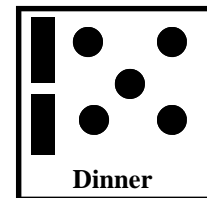
Lecture
