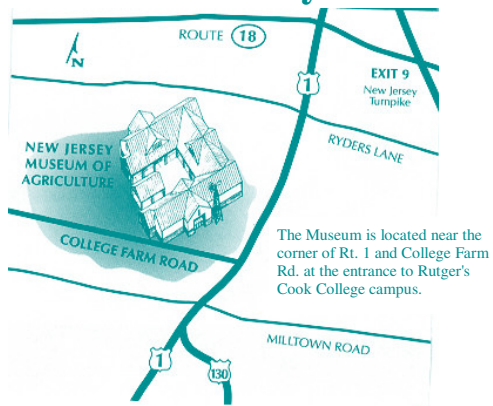
Preserving Garden State Heritage
