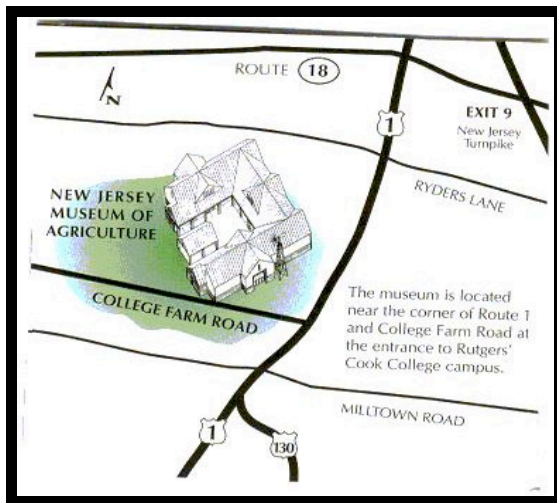

### The Lobby

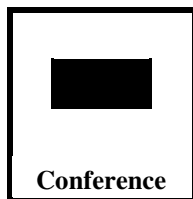

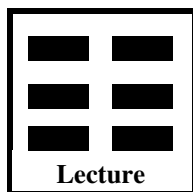
### Room Set-up



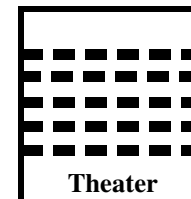
Horseshoe style is optimum for presenters and speakers who are looking for feedback from the group, yet also allows the front of the room to be the center of focus.



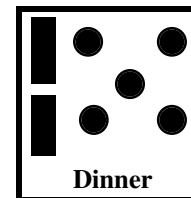
Conference style allows for maximum communication between all group members, allowing everyone to sit and see each other.



Lecture style allows group members to focus on the front of the room, yet still have room to work on notes or projects on the table.



Theater style is primarily used for use of the TV/VCR, slide or power point presentations, or specific training sessions.



Dinner set-up is an exceptional way for your group to socialize. Please note that the Museum only supplies rectangular tables and 120 chairs. Round tables and additional chairs must be provided from an outside agency.

### Catered Events

The Museum does not have the facilities to provide catering. Caterers must provide round tables, all table coverings and related items. Food items cannot be stored overnight. Please call the Museum office for more information about local caterers and our guidelines for alcoholic beverages.

### Guided Tours

Guided tours of the Museum and nearby Cook Campus animal barns is a lovely addition to your meeting or party. Please call the Museum office for tour rates and conditions.

### Custodial Services
